

Task Force to identify laws and unlawful antiChristian conduct.



- 1/31 Enforce 2020 Title IX Rule-biological sex
- 2/17 Cut over \$600 million in Divisive Teacher Training Grants
- 2/13 Cancels \$350 million in Woke spending (TA Centers)
- 2/15 Directs Schools to End Racial References-admissions and hirings
- 2/20 Reduces Federal Overreach in Charter Schools Programs
- 2/19 Cancels Divisive and Wasteful Grants for Comprehensive Centers
- 2/4 Letter to districts sex-protected laws promote the reality that there are two sexes-male/female



2. I anticipate that a significant number of families in my public school community would opt for other alternative educational settings if they were ... o use a school voucher to leave their public school. 105 responses








9. Which Title funds would you prioritize to retain? Check all that apply.


