	Tier 2 Targeted Intervention	School provides short-term targeted support for students who have difficulty demonstrating appropriate SEL skills. Interventions are typically developed through the Foundations team or Student Support Team. 	Tier 3 Intensive	Students with the highest level of need receive highly structured individualized interventions and wrap around supports. Supports are implemented with consultation from specialists (e.g., counselors, behavior specialists, school psychologists, etc.).
